- Sports dress
- Unlined jacket and skirt or pants
- Pullover shirt with skirt or pants
- Pajamas and robe
- Nightgown and robe

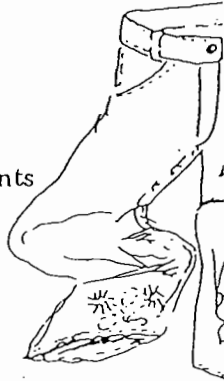
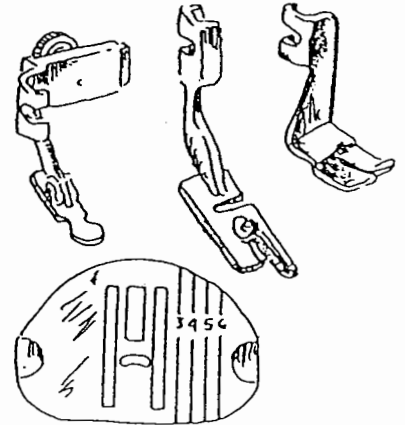

Learn and Do At Least Four New Construction Techniques

- To machine and hand sew more carefully
- To use pressing equipment
- To make machine and/or hand-worked buttonholes
- To match stripes and/or large designs
- To tape seams
- To finish seams
- To underline a garment
- To topstitch
- To make pattern alterations for a good fit
- To work with single knits
- To put in an invisible zipper
- To select suitable interfacings and linings for different fabrics
- To learn more about the sewing machine--new stitches and/or new attachments
- To make notched collars
- To apply trim
- To do different hem finishes
- To use fusibles
